

Privacy Policy

This policy describes the principles of processing of Personal Data that is submitted to FastValidate through the use of the Website, Software and Services. If you choose to use FastValidate, then you agree to the collection and use of information in relation to this policy. Please read this policy carefully to understand and familiarize yourself with this policy as this policy constitutes an integral part of the agreement entered into between the Clients and FastValidate.

This policy also constitutes an agreement between you (as Controller of Personal Data) and FastValidate (as Processor of Personal Data) in the meaning of article 28 of GDPR (EU General Data Protection Regulation).

The Personal Information that I collect is used for providing and improving the Service. I will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy.

FastValidate shall be entitled to unilaterally review and amend this Policy from time to time. You may review the most recent version of the privacy policy at any time here.

If you do not agree with any or all terms of this Policy or any possible changes to it, then they should immediately close the Website and cease using the Website, Software and Services.

Definitions

1. **"you", "your" or "Client(s)"** means legal entities who register themselves on the Website and use it and the Software according to these Terms for the purpose of using the Services.
2. **"we", "us" and "our"** refer to the **FastValidate** Service which is solely created, represented and run by the Individual: Thomas Aaron Linstead.
3. **"data subjects"** mean all natural persons, whose personal data is submitted to FastValidate in connection with using the Website, Software and Services.

4. “**GDPR**” is the regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC.
5. “**policy**” means the current privacy policy of FastValidate.
6. “**processing**” means any operation or set of operations which is performed on Personal Data or on sets of Personal Data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction.
7. “**service(s)**” refers to the validation service that we provide and the Website, Software and Services thereof.
8. “**terms**” means these Terms of Service and all terms, policies and guidelines incorporated into the Terms by reference, including, but not limited to, Privacy Policy and User Agreement.

2. Retention Periods

FastValidate shall preserve the Personal Data as long as it is required for the use of the Website, Software and Services, but no longer than applicable law permits preservation.

FastValidate shall delete the Personal Data submitted by the Clients 30 days after the Client has filed a claim to delete such data. You confirm that you agree with the provided above retention periods.

3. Personal Data that FastValidate Processes

FastValidate currently provides members with services to validate Email, Phone and Address Information. For the purpose of provision of the Website, Software and the Services, we process the Personal Data you provide about your own clients, who are the recipients of the Services. The types of such data depend on the decision of the Clients how they want to use the Services and generally include but are not limited to emails, telephone numbers and addresses.

Personal Data submitted regarding your data subjects is not stored by FastValidate and only processes data for the purpose of using the Website, Software and Services. Results of processing are securely stored, however the personal data submitted of the data subject is omitted from the stored result. This helps you to be compliant with GDPR with you (as Controller of Personal Data) and FastValidate (as Processor of Personal Data) in the meaning of article 28 of GDPR (EU General Data Protection Regulation).

Personal Data provided regarding you, the Client for the purpose of provision of the Website, Software and the Services including but not limited to emails, passwords and ip address are required for the purpose of use of the Website, Software and the Services. FastValidate processes your Personal Data upon communication between Clients and/or Data Subjects with customer support of FastValidate in connection with the Website, Software and Services.

FastValidate works closely with third parties (including, for example, business partners, sub-contractors in technical and payment services) and may receive Personal Data from them or submit personal data to them for processing for the purpose of use of the Website, Software and the Services.

FastValidate sends messages to you, the Client by electronic means (e-mail or SMS) with information about improvements of the Website, Software and Services, new proposals and developments (direct marketing). The Client may at any time unsubscribe from correspondence by clicking on the corresponding specific link contained within.

4. Legal Basis

FastValidate processes Personal Data in accordance with the laws of the location where the processing of Personal Data is conducted.

We process Personal Data submitted by you, the Client based on the contract with you for the purpose of using the Website, Software and Services.

In accordance with Article 4 (7) of GDPR you, the Client are the controller of Personal Data that you submit to FastValidate for the purpose of using the Website, Software and Services, including the data regarding clients of the Clients. According to Article 4 (8) of GDPR FastValidate acts as the processor on the Client's behalf when processing the Personal Data submitted by the Clients.

Therefore you, the Client are fully responsible for the processing of Personal Data that you submit to FastValidate and guarantee to FastValidate explicitly that you in order to use the Website, Software and Services have all the necessary consents and/or other legal grounds from Data Subjects for lawful processing of Personal Data in accordance with this Policy. You oblige to inform FastValidate immediately of the expiry of legal grounds for processing, modification, inaccuracy or change to the Personal Data that the Clients submit.

FastValidate shall assist you with appropriate technical and organisational measures, as is possible, for the fulfilment of the Clients' obligation to respond to requests for exercising of Data Subject's rights laid down in GDPR, including the right of access to Personal Data by Data Subjects, right to rectification, right to be forgotten and right to restriction of processing.

FastValidate shall assist you in ensuring compliance with the obligations of guarantying security of processing of Personal Data as per GDPR while taking into account the nature of processing.

We apply appropriate technical and organisational measures aimed to insure security, confidentiality and integrity of data.

We periodically monitor its internal processes and processing of Personal Data conducted by Third Parties and the to ensure that processing of Personal Data is in accordance with the applicable law.

FastValidate will notify you, the Client in the most expedient time possible under the circumstances and without unreasonable delay and, where feasible, after having become aware of any accidental, unauthorised, or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, or disclosure of, or access to, Personal Data (herein: Security Breach).

5. Transfer of Personal Data to Third Parties

FastValidate uses, for providing the Service and access to the Website and Software, different third party service providers, to whom it may also transfer Personal Data. You are duly informed and expressly authorize, totally or partially, to use the corresponding Third Party service providers and provide Personal Data to them, as it may be required. These service providers include the following:

FastValidate makes its best efforts to limit the amount of Personal Data that it transfers for processing to Third Parties as is necessary for the provision of specific services.

Our Website and Software may also contain links that redirect to other websites. This Policy does not apply to such third party websites, which FastValidate does not operate and we do not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies.

5. Security Measures for Protection of Personal Data

FastValidate stores all data on secured servers and we take the appropriate legal, organizational and technical measures to protect Personal Data consistent with applicable privacy and data security laws. Security measures shall be applied to protect Personal Data from involuntary or unauthorized processing, disclosure or destruction. All passwords are encrypted using strong one-way hashing algorithm and are never stored in plain text. No method of transmission over the internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure and reliable, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

Access for the Clients to the Website is protected with individual usernames and passwords. The Clients are responsible for keeping passwords confidential. The Clients are obliged not to share passwords with anyone. In case of suspicion of unauthorized access, the Clients are obliged to immediately inform FastValidate in such an event.
